Why should we gradually replace all petrol cars by electric cars?

The main problem of an electric car is its autonomy when you have to travel long distances. How about having a break while the battery of your electric car is charged for 2 hours?

An electric vehicle does not necessarily emit low carbon: it could have nearly as large a footprint as a petrol car, depending on how the electricity is generated. Certain motorway petrol stations in England are offering a free charge using wind turbines and solar panels if you register on line at these stations.

The economic argument can be really interesting and using an electric car can really contribute to saving the environment.
